Police Ombudsman's role extended

On March 16th 2015 the Police Ombudsman's Office became the body that investigates serious complaints and concerns about the conduct of officials carrying out immigration and custom duties in Northern Ireland.

Prior to this development there has been no independent system in place here for dealing with such matters. The move follows an agreement between the Home Secretary, Teresa May, and the Police Ombudsman, Dr Michael Maguire.
