## <u>Detention officer justified in striking</u> <u>teenager</u>

A Police Ombudsman investigation has concluded that a civilian police employee who struck a teenager used "necessary force" after being bitten on the hand.

## No misconduct in police seizure of phone

An investigation into a complaint that the police confiscated a woman's mobile phone so they could destroy footage of them carrying out an assault has found no evidence of police misconduct.

### <u>Discipline for suspicious death</u> <u>failings</u>

The Police Ombudsman has recommended disciplinary action against ten police officers after finding failings in the way police investigated a man's disappearance and suspicious death.
